RECYCLE.....at your convenience!

All recycling in Kalida benefits Four Seasons Park. We estimate if every-body in the Kalida area recycled their paper, cardboard, aluminum and steel for Four Seasons Park over \$40,000 per year would be generated!! While we currently are no where near that number, it is possible! Please consider recycling these items to benefit Four Seasons Park. It's easy to do! Help us build your new park!

It is very easy to recycle **STEEL**, **ALUMINUM**, **COPPER**, **CARDBOARD**, and **PAPER** in Kalida.

Lighted Drop Off Site is open 24-7 at Village Maintenance facility (west of Kalida on St.Rt.114).

Just follow instructions on signs and place aluminum, copper, cardboard & paper in semi-trailers, or place steel items in roll off container.

*ALL KINDS OF STEEL IS ACCEPTABLE, including refrigerators,

stoves, furnaces, hot water heaters, old farm equipment and rinsed steel food cans. Larger/heavier steel items can be placed on the ground beside the roll off container.

*ALL KINDS OF ALUMINUM IS ACCEPTABLE, including aluminum door frames and siding, but especially aluminum cans.

Note: If you are having a large gathering or party where aluminum cans will be used, special white 55 gallon plastic recycling barrels are available to help in recycling aluminum cans. Call 419-615-7221 for more info.

*USED COPPER PIPES, BRASS & WIRING can be placed at the rear of the Aluminum recycling trailer.

*ALL KINDS OF CARDBOARD IS ACCEPTABLE from the smallest to the largest pieces. Recycle ALL your household & commercial cardboard.

*ALL KINDS OF PAPER IS ACCEPTABLE including newspaper, magazines, envelopes, junk mail, books, etc. Recycle ALL your clean household/office paper including shredded paper.

ADDITIONAL RECYCLING INFO:

*PLASTIC bottles & containers can be recycled at this same Kalida location, in the County's blue roll off container **ONLY** the **FIRST FULL WEEK** of every month from noon on Monday until noon on Friday. Plastic items can, however, be recycled anytime at drop off site at Wal-Mart in Ottawa.

*GLASS bottles can be recycled anytime at drop off site at Wal-Mart in Ottawa. Please separate by color.

*Kalida Elementary School collects "**BOX TOPS** for education" and **CAMPBELL'S** "labels for education". Please remove these before recycling cereal boxes, etc. & soup cans. These can be sent in with a student or brought to either Kalida school office. Playground equipment and other items are earned with these.

*USED COMPUTERS, CLOTHING, FURNITURE & HOUSEHOLD ITEMS can be recycled at Goodwill Industries in Ottawa. Call ahead to verify on computers and larger items.

*OLD TV's and ELECTRONICS should be recycled and not placed in the trash. Check with your local TV & Electronics retailer for proper disposal options. Some big box TV & Electronic retailers offer no charge recycling options for old TV's & Electronics. More information can be found on their web sites.

*USED TIRES should be recycled and not left where water can collect and stagnate for mosquitoes to breed in. Check with your local tire retailer for tire recycling options. Occasionally, the County may offer and publicize special tire recycling options for county residents.

*USED EYEGLASSES are recycled by the Kalida Lions Club. These are refurbished and donated for use by individuals in less fortunate areas of the world. Please place used eyeglasses in containers at any of these Kalida locations: Post Office, Union Bank and Huntington Bank.

*Consider ordering your yearly household **WASHING MACHINE DETERGENT & FABRIC SOFTNER** needs in bulk from the Kalida Athletic Boosters annual fund raiser (place order in in Jan.-Feb.). Purchasing in bulk eliminates recycling smaller plastic containers, as detergent & softner comes in reusable five gallon buckets.

*If you have unwanted, unused or expired **MEDICATIONS**, do not flush them down the toilet or place in your trash, as that can pollute the environment! There is a secure drop off box (open 24-7) for these located in the entrance of the Putnam Co. Sheriff's office in Ottawa.
