Putnam County Health Department Immunizations

According to the Ohio Department of Health rules, incoming 12th graders for the 2019-20 school year are required to have one or two doses of the Meningitis vaccine (MCV4) for entry into the 12th grade.



Students entering the <u>7th grade</u> next school year <u>are required</u> to have one dose of both the Tdap and Meningitis (MCV4) for entry into the 7th grade.

The Health Department has immunization clinics every Tuesday from 9:00 –11:30 AM and 1:00 –4:00 PM. On the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of each month, the hours are extended to 6:00 PM. The 4th Wednesday of each month they hold morning hours 9:30—11:30 AM. Any questions? Please call the health department at 419-523-5608.

Kindergarten screening will take place on April 3 and April 4. We currently have 59 youngsters signed-up for screening. Welcome to the class of 2032!


