CONGRATULATIONS KALIDA ELEMENTARY – AN OAESA HALL OF FAME SCHOOL

Congratulations to the staff, students, and parents on the recent award from the Ohio Association of Elementary School Administrators. Kalida Elementary School was one of only five schools in the state of Ohio to receive the 2013 Hall of Fame School Recognition Award. The following letter was provided by the Dr. Julie Davis, the Executive Director of the OAESA:

The Ohio Association of Elementary School Administrators announced that Kalida Elementary School in the Kalida Local School District is a winner of the 2013 Hall of Fame School Recognition Award. Mr. Karl Lammers and the elementary staff will be presented with the award at an Awards Luncheon on June 19, 2013 during the annual OAESA Professional Conference. OAESA will recognize five elementary Hall of Fame schools during the 2013 Awards Luncheon.

The finalists were selected from nominations across the state. The school staff submitted extensive written documentation substantiating the quality of their educational program in the following areas:

- Instructional System
- Student Achievement
- Student Development
- Personnel
- Administration
- School Management
- Stakeholders

Hall of Fame Award winners were chosen by two committees of principals; one of which read and scored the applications and the other conducted on-site evaluations of the schools. The five winning Hall of Fame schools represent the finest schools in the state of Ohio. The award is a testament to the hard work and dedication of our staff and students and the incredible support of our parents and community. EXCELLENT TWELVE YEARS IN A ROW -Kalida Local Schools was recognized as an Excellent school district by the Ohio Department of Education for the 2011-2012 school year. This the twelfth consecutive year Kalida Local Schools has achieved this designation. Congratulations to our staff, students, and parents on continuing Kalida Local Schools "*Tradition of Excellence*".

SCHOOL SAFETY TRAININGS - In light of recent national, state, and local events, all of the staff members of Kalida Local Schools have and will be receiving additional training in a number of areas. These trainings are being offered in addition to our normal building and district wide sessions on school safety, blood borne pathogens, emergency procedures, and mandatory reporting requirements.

On March 4, all of the staff members at Kalida Local Schools were involved in an initial two hour introductory training on active shooters and intruders referred to as A.L.I.C.E Training. This training title stands for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, and Evacuate. The entire staff was given an opportunity to hear from Mr. Scott Stant of the Pandora Police Department and Deputy Randy Weller of the Putnam County Sheriff's Department. The staff was introduced to techniques designed to make it more difficult for an active shooter to hurt students, as well as techniques on how to improve communication and evacuation procedures during this type of emergency. Kalida Local Schools has also had a number of staff members who have received the full eight hour training in the past, and additional staff members will be attending the full training on two separate dates in April.

On May 24, Mr. John Basinger will be talking to all of the school staff members about sexual assault and sexual abuse and its effects on students. Mr. Basinger will cover a range of topics to help our staff understand these horrible events through the eyes of both the victims and the perpetrators. The goal is to help our staff members gain a better understanding of possible warning signs and a better understanding of how to work with and help students who are victims of abuse. Following this meeting theme, we will have representatives from the Putnam County Prosecutor's Office, Job and Family Services, and the Sheriff's Department talk with our staff on August 19. The purpose of this meeting will be to discuss mandatory reporting practices, and what our staff members can do to help these three agencies when reporting suspected cases of abuse. The district has also invited Father Mark and the religious education staff at St. Michael's to attend these sessions with the school staff.

KALIDA LOCAL SCHOOLS HAS A FACEBOOK PRESENCE


