# Let's Hear it for the FFA Girls!

Megan Schulte- Class of 2019: After being one of the first female Kalida FFA members to earn her State FFA Degree in 2020, Megan Schulte has continued on with her groundbreaking achievements. Megan is now the first female and fifth student in the history of the Kalida FFA Chapter to earn her American Degree. Only 0.5% of all FFA members will be awarded this accomplishment. Requirements for the American FFA Degree include having taken at least 540 hours of agricultural education courses, participate in 50 hours of community services, and earn



\$10,000 in a Supervised Agricultural Experience or S.A.E. Megan will be recognized at the 93rd Annual National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana this October.

Marcy Landwehr-Class of 2021: Marcy joins the ranks of Kalida FFA History by becoming the 4th female student to obtain her State FFA Degree and the first ever student to win Ohio's District 4 with her Goat Production Placement S.A.E. A supervised agricultural experience requires FFA members to find work in an internship (paid or unpaid) or begin their own entrepreneurial pursuits. State FFA Degrees are awarded to those students who earn \$2,500 in their S.A.E., participate in 270 hours of agriculture education courses, attend a minimum of eight state level activities, and donate 25 hours of time to community service.

<u>Brooke Siefker-Class of 2021</u>: Brooke continues her awards accomplishments by becoming the first member in Kalida FFA History to place 2nd in Ohio District 4's Dairy Production Placement S.A.E. category. Brooke will be recognized for this accomplishment as well as her two years of service as Kalida FFA President at the Kalida FFA Banquet taking place in May.

# Putnam County Health Department Immunization Rules

Incoming <u>7th graders</u> for the 2021-2022 school year are required to have one dose of both **Tdap and Meningitis** (MCV4) for entry into the 7th grade.

Incoming <u>12th graders</u> for the 2021-2022 school year are also still required to have one or two doses of meningitis vaccine for entry into 12th grade. The required **Meningitis vaccine is MCV4.** It protects against four strains of Meningitis (A,C,W, Y). Two doses of the vaccine are required; however, if the first dose was administered on or after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required. So if your child has never received this vaccine and is now over 16 years old, one dose would meet this requirement.

The health department is maintaining social distancing guidelines during all clinics. Please consider scheduling an appointment early because we cannot allow more people in the building than distancing rules can safely support. August is typically very congested with full clinics. Do not delay this year. Call 419-523-5608 to schedule an appointment.

## Athletic Physicals for 2021-2022

Due to a variety of factors, most of which are out of the control of the school, Kalida High School and the athletic department will no longer be offering a free physical night at the school in the spring.
