## THANK YOU TO THREE GREAT ORGANIZATIONS

Kalida Local Schools would like to thank the Enhancement Committee, the Music Boosters, and the Athletic Boosters for their financial support of three spring projects which are being finished up this month. All three projects will benefit our students and/or the district community.

The Enhancement Committee supported the completion of a sidewalk project which will link the weight room area and the northwest gym entrances to the Lion's Park footbridge. This project will make these areas more



accessible to families and students by allowing foot traffic to move from the park area to the school with a direct route. The Enhancement Committee is also getting ready to start work on two additional projects over the summer and fall. The Committee members are reviewing and finalizing plans for a press box in the gymnasium and they are looking at plans for additional landscaping in the green space between the bus and student parking lots. The committee members and the district are working with Verhoff Machine &

Welding on the fabrication and installation of the press box, and the landscaping will be installed as part of an Eagle Scout project.

The Music Boosters supported the construction of a band storage and observation facility. Since the construction of the new high school started in 2004, the band lost their long time practice area. With the completion of the new building, and the leveling, seeding, and fertilizing of the ground behind the building, the band will now have their own practice facility. This will help reduce practice scheduling conflicts with other activities, and take pressure off of those other facilities.





The Athletic Boosters helped fund and construct the new batting cage located by the softball diamond. This has been a long term need for the program, and the Boosters came up with an innovative solution. The batting cage has been constructed to take advantage of the asphalt drive behind the gymnasium to save the cost of a base for the structure. The batting cage design will allow the cage to be taken down if we need to get vehicles along the drive, and since it can be taken down after the spring season we can extend the life of the netting and support structure.

Thanks again to all three of these groups for their continued support of the students and programs at Kalida Local Schools.

# **Cats Who Care**

The Cats Who Care service organization of KHS recently held a drive to benefit the Safe Harbor in Lima. Safe Harbor is a runaway and homeless youth shelter. #### Student Athletic Physicals 2012-13 In order for a physical to be valid for the next school year, it must be done May 1, 2012 or there after. - OHSAA

All students must have a physical on file before they begin practicing with any athletic team. This year, there will be FREE physicals for students who will be entering grades **9-12** during the upcoming school year. Physicals will be administerd by Dr. Klir and Dr. Horstman to **high school students ONLY** on Monday, May 14, 2012 in the HS gymnasium from 6:00 PM until 7:30 PM. <u>Anyone arriving after 7:30 PM will not</u> <u>be given a physical.</u>

Kalida High School no longer provides FREE physicals to students entering grade 7 or grade 8. Students will have to obtain a physical from their family doctor. An alternative choice would be a **FREE** physical on May 7, 2012 or May 14, 2012 at the *Orthopaedic Institute of Ohio (OIO)* from 5:30 - 8:00 PM. These are the only two dates of this free offer. Students choosing to go to the Orthopaedic Institute (801 Medical Drive, Suite A, Lima) must first fill out the *Consent for Pre-Participation Physical Form* and then bring it with them along with the 6 page physical form on May 7 or May 14 at OIO.

Forms are available in the high school office. Remember to have your form filled out **prior** to your physical and if you wear glasses you must <u>bring them</u> with you to the physical.

*Added note:* Dr. Horstman and Dr. Klir would like to remind all parents that the exam done through KHS is a preparticipation exam and not a full physical. Students are still encouraged to visit their personal physican annually. Additionally, all junior high students should have received counsel about age appropriate vaccines and this should be addressed with your child's physician.

#### Putnam County Health Dept.

Students entering the 7th grade for the 2012-13 school year are required to have a **Tdap vaccine booster** for entry into the 7th grade according to the Ohio Department of Health rules. Tdap vaccine protects against three diseases--Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertusis (Whooping Cough)--and is administered in one shot. Also available at the Health Department are the recommended vaccines: MCV4 (meningitis), HPV (Human Papilomavirus), HBV (Hepatitis B) and VAR (Chicken Pox/Varicella).

The health department has immunization clinics every Tuesday from 9:00 - 11:30 AM and 1:00-4:00 PM with extended hours until 6:00 PM on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of each month, and the 4th Wednesday of each month from 9:30 - 11:45 AM. If you have any questions please call 419-523-5608.
