# **Notes from Superintendent ~ Don Horstman**

#### **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

The elementary school building is moving closer to completion, and our contractors are moving into the final phases on the new academic wing. The weather has slowed down some of the exterior work, but we are getting closer to the day when the concrete begins to be installed for the playground. Many of the classrooms have the cabinets and lockers installed, and the majority of the windows have all been installed. They are continuing to wrap up the wiring for the technology, electrical work, and the plumbing. The interior masonry has all been completed, and most of the restroom flooring has been installed.

The contractors have also started on the renovation portion of the project. They have started to remove the ceiling tile and insulation in the classrooms, cafeteria, and hallways, and will then move on to removing the floor tile in these areas. The cafeteria, classroom and hallway lights will also be removed and replaced as a part of the project. As soon as the weather begins to cooperate we hope to have the roofing contractor begin removing the old roofing, and begin preparing to install the new membrane roof. In another area the district is working with Sarka Electric and AEP to take advantage of grants to replace all of the remaining lighting on the existing end of the building with more energy efficient fixtures. This should significantly lower the electrical usage in this area of the building and result in lower utility costs for the district.

#### **All Sport Passes - August**

Passes will be sold in the Administration Office beginning the first week in August from 8:00 AM - 3 PM. Reserved seating for the basketball games will be sold during the basketball season for an additional fee. Prices for the All Sport Pass will be announced next month.

**OGT Results:** Results have arrived for the five sections of the Ohio Graduation Test which were given to all sophomores in March. Again, it appears that Kalida will rank near the top in comparison to other schools in the area and state. Parents of sophomores should have received results with each student's report card. The next testing session for students not passing respective parts will be in October. The following results indicate the percent passing each respective part along with the number of students for the sophomore class:

<u>Student Schedules for the 2010-11 School Year:</u> Students who will be entering grades 7-12 next school year can pick-up class schedules beginning on August 20. Schedules will be available in the middle school/high school office from 8 AM - 3 PM. This will, hopefully, allow students sufficient time to make scheduling changes if needed before the school year begins.

<u>Sixth Grade Orientation Scheduled:</u> An orientation for students and parents of the students entering the sixth grade will be held on **Thursday, August 19 at 10 AM.** Student schedules will be distributed at that time and other important information will be shared that will be relevant to the school environment.

Class of 2010 Summary: The class of 2010 of Kalida High School was composed of 48 graduates. Thirtyeight plan to attend 16 different post-secondary colleges or universities while the other 10 will seek to use the skills of their trades learned at the Vantage Career Center to enter the job market. All but one of our college-bound students will be staying within the borders of Ohio for their education. Here is a breakdown of their destinations. The big winner for this year for the school who will get the most Kalida grads - The Ohio State University with 9-6 will start at the main campus in our state's capital while the other 3 will begin at the Lima campus. Eleven other graduates will also be starting out on campuses in Lima – 6 at James A. Rhodes State College and 5 at the University of Northwestern Ohio. Seven more will be flying up and down Interstate – 75 in the northern part of the state – 4 as Falcons at Bowling Green State University, 2 as Rockets at the University of Toledo, and one at Owens Community College. Six more will be heading south - with 3 attending Wright St., 1 at Xavier University, 1 at Miami University in Oxford, and the 6th will be trading in her Wildcat claws for Bearcat claws at the University of Cincinnati. One senior will be going for a much bigger claw – that of a Polar Bear at Ohio Northern University. Finally, 4 other grads will be attending Northwest St. in Archbold, Terra Community College in Tiffin, Columbus State and ITT in Ft. Wayne. One of our seniors will be serving our country in the U.S. Air Force. We are proud of all the accomplishments of this group who can now call themselves alumni of Kalida High School. Congratulations and best of luck in all your future endeavors!!
