Greetings from the Superintendent

We've made it through the first nine weeks of school and into November. Not a day goes by that we aren't impacted by the world of COVID-19. It has consumed us at times; and on occasion, has occupied the greater portion of the work week. To date, we have had eleven positive cases among students and eleven on our staff. Over 20% of our students have missed days of school due to positive tests, quarantining, or symptoms monitoring.

It's natural to get complacent over time and we have all been guilty of letting our guard down. Constant reminders are issued to wear masks, social distance, sanitize, monitor symptoms and to avoid long periods of time gathering in groups. The guidelines have not changed since the "Return to School" letter was issued back in August. Putnam County is the hotspot in Ohio and we must continue to be diligent with our guidelines for the sake of everyone. Even then, an outbreak may be unavoidable. Multiple school districts in the county have switched to a different delivery format out of necessity and we are also prepared to move in that direction. However, the staff and I are dedicated to stay with in person instruction as long as it is possible.

On a couple other fronts, the 'Free Meals for All' program has been extended through the school year. On October 9, the USDA announced extensions of the national waiver operations through June. I want to publicly recognize our cafeteria manager, Sarah Neidert, and her crew for serving great meals while fiscally and efficiently operating a topnotched food service program.

Kalida Local Schools, in conjunction with The Putnam County ADAMHS Board, are making an effort to shed light on adolescent and adult mental health. Suicide awareness is critical. Recognizing someone struggling or behaving differently is an important step to intervention and possibly saving a life. Sometimes, just asking someone if they are OK is enough to get them back on track. While we haven't met in large groups this year because of the circumstances, we are still providing support and care for each other. This week, each student will receive a small pack of disinfecting wet wipes with the simple message of R U OK? We will build on that throughout the year to promote both physical and mental health well-being.

As the holiday season approaches, uncertainty continues to hover over each day. Thank you all for the extra effort and on behalf of everyone at Kalida Local Schools, may you have a blessed and healthy end to 2020.



Practice ACT Test for Juniors

Kalida High School and Sylvan Learning Center will again be sponsoring this year a practice ACT for all KHS juniors. The assessment will be administered at KHS on **Thursday**, **January 7** and will cost \$10. Students can register and pay in the high school office. Payment should be made in cash or check made payable to **Sylvan Learning Center**. This practice test - which will precede the state sponsored ACT in February - will enable students to get the experience of taking the assessment before the state sponsored ACT in February. Students will receive a score report upon completion as well as a 30-day individualized code for the Sylvan website from which they can access their test scores and view review tutorials on how missed questions should have been answered.

Kalida High School in conjunction with Ft. Jennings and Ottoville will be sponsoring an ACT prep camp next spring on various dates in late May/early June. More details will follow at a later date.
