#### CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The high school construction project is coming right down to the wire and we have contractors working to complete items so we can start school on time. While we will start school on August 31 as scheduled, some items will still need to be completed after the start of school. The items needing to be completed will not affect the teachers and students in the classroom. The students will not have to travel through construction areas when moving around the building or from the modular units to the other buildings. The new building is going to be a great facility for years to come, and it will serve our staff, students and community very well.

All of the student chairs, desks, and teacher furnishings have been installed and we are completing last minute cleaning and waxing. The Smart Boards have all been installed, the video monitors are almost complete, and the new elevator has been approved for use. The contractors have installed the new parking lots, most of the sidewalks, and we are getting ready to stripe the parking lots late next week.



The elementary project is well under way with the library and first/second grade wings being taken down first. The new boiler room is really taking

shape, and we are preparing to go out to bid the first week of September. The architect is confident we will be able to complete the project in time for school in the fall of 2010, and we will probably have a similar start date next year to help ensure we have enough time to complete all the necessary work.

#### DEDICATION CEREMONY

When we originally scheduled the date for the school dedication the contractors all assured us they would have their necessary work completed by August 14. The district even delayed the printing of the newsletter last month



to give the contractors and our construction manner time to verify those dates, but unfortunately they have not been able to keep their promise. The dedication will take place on Sunday, September 27 at 11:45 a.m. The Kalida Cross Country team will be hosting a barbecued pork loin dinner from 11:00 to 1:00. The cost of the dinner is \$7.00 and includes pork loin, potato salad, applesauce and roll. Please contact Rob Schnippel, Scott Miller or a member of the cross country team for tickets. We look forward to showcasing the new building to the district residents, and look forward to seeing as many people as possible at the dedication.
