New Arrival and Dismissal Procedures at Kalida High School Building

MORNING DROP-OFF

- Drop-off at the front doors of the high school building.
- NO student-drop off in the Bus Parking Lot.
- All students that are walking or riding bikes through the bus parking lot, please stay close to the soccer field fence and continue along that route until you reach the sidewalk that runs in front of the bus parking lines. Follow sidewalk to the front doors of the building.

AFTERNOON DISMISSAL

- No Students will be permitted to park by the high school soccer field school days from 7:00 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.
- The parking lot between the gym and administrative building will be for **buses only**.
- <u>ALL parent pick-up</u> will be in the **black top parking lot** off third street. <u>Parents will no longer pick-up</u> students by the school building, Administration building or in the Bus Parking lot.
 - At 3:00 p.m. a staff member will walk all *parent pick-up students in the 5th—8th grade* from the

school

building out to the black top parking lot.

- At 3:05 p.m. all remaining students will be released, including 9th-12th parent pick-up students.
- All **Sophomore student parking** will be in the **blacktop parking lot** off third street.
- ♦ **Junior and Senior parking** along with staff parking will remain the same.
- Reminder: All yellow striped parking spots in the high school lot are for staff parking only.
- All 5th-8th Grade students that are being picked up by parents will be released at 3:00 p.m.
- ◆ All other students in the 5th-12th grades will be released at the normal time 3:05 p.m.

Thank you for your cooperation with our new Arrival/Dismissal procedures. Please share this with any family members that will be dropping off or picking up your student from the high school building. We understand that it will take some time for everyone to get accustomed to the new arrival and dismissal procedures. We feel these changes will make the dismissal process safer for all students.

New Text and or Email Notification System

You should have received an email for a link. You can also select the ParentSquare Link on the district website, under the Resources Tab. The <u>Getting Started One-Pager</u> will help you learn more. You'll notice many features you're familiar with from Remind, as well as new capabilities that support stronger communication with your child's school. If you have questions, visit the Help section by clicking the question mark at the top of the website or the triple bar icon in the app. These will take you to resources such as the help articles, which include answers to frequently asked questions.

For Community Members (without students in the Local School District):

If you are not a parent/student or staff member of Kalida Local Schools, you can sign up for general alerts (Weather and Athletics). You can access ParentSquare Link on the districts website, under the Resources Tab select "ParentSquare (Alerts) Remind replacement" then the "Community Group sign-up Form".

PaySchools Central allows you to monitor the student's lunch pur-

chases & balance, limit student lunch spending, add money to their lunch account, transfer money between siblings, sign up for low account text alerts and enter an online Free & Reduced-Price Meal Application. If you have not already created an account with www.payschoolscentral.com, we encourage you to create your account.

- ** You <u>may</u> also pay for your student fees through PaySchool Central, but there are Convenience and Processing Fees that will be charge. The following fees will be incurred for each PaySchools Central Transaction:
 - Paid with Checking-account transfer: \$1.25
 - Paid with debit or credit card: 3.25%

You may continue to send <u>cash or check</u> to the school in an envelope with the student's name, ID/lunch account number and amount enclosed for your child's lunch account and student bookbill/fees to avoid the PaySchool Central processing fees.

Free and Reduced Meal Applications

If you have not already created a PaySchools Central account, please follow the directions above to create your account and apply. Those eligible for free/reduced lunches must re-apply.
