Kalida Elementary will continue to grant release time for elementary students during morning hours. For any student to participate, a parent permission form must be completed and on file in the office.

### **Back to School Night**

Our annual Back to School Night will be Thursday, August 20, from 7:00-8:00 p.m. Parents and students are invited to meet their teacher, drop off school supplies and check out their classroom. The office will also be open to allow parents to pay book fees and lunch money, and purchase recorders for music, if necessary. Forms that are usually distributed the first day of school will also be available so parents have more time to complete them.

## **Drop Offs and Pickups**

As in the past, we will use Fourth Street for most of our drop off and pick up procedures. It is extremely important to use only the curb side nearest the elementary building when dropping off students in the morning. This is to ensure your child's safety so they do not have to cross in front of oncoming traffic. All students must enter the main doors by the office or the gym doors. Students being picked up at the end of the day are dismissed at 2:50. Cars must be gone by 2:55 so our buses may take their loading positions at that time.
