# **Attendance Policy**

When your child is absent from school, a parent or guardian needs to call to inform the school that morning. In the high school the number to call is 419-532-3543 and in the elementary call 419-532-3845. When the child returns to school a note needs to be given to the office with details explaining the absence whether it be illness or appointment and the date(s) of the absence(s). All notes need to be signed and dated by the parent or guardian.

For medical or dental appointments, a doctor's note stating the student was treated in the office is an acceptable note for attendance issues.

If a vacation is planned during the school year, the offices should be notified and trip approved prior to the vacation date. Truant officers will be called if a student is absent without notifying the school. Please check your school hand-book for further details concerning this issue.
