Final Forms Reminder

We are asking that ALL parents of students use FinalForms prior to the start of school.

We have partnered with FinalForms, an online forms and data management service that is replacing paper forms. FinalForms allows you to complete and sign enrollment, back-to-school and athletic participation forms for your students (ONLINE). The most exciting news is that FinalForms saves data from season-to-season and year-to-year, meaning that you will never need to enter the same information twice! FinalForms also pre-populates information wherever possible, for each of your students, saving you time.

You may review and update your data online at any time to verify it is current. You will be required to sign your forms once per year and after any update.

Click on the Parent Playbook (on our website) to get started in FinalForms. If you require any support during the process, scroll to the page bottom and click "Use Support".

Thank you for your assistance in streamlining our paperwork processes at Kalida Local Schools.

School Begins August 23, 2022

Now- Parents completion of the FinalForms must be finished NOW for the upcoming school year. Most paperwork normally sent home on the first day of school can now be processed.

Free and Reduced Applications for the lunch program are now available online in the FinalForms site. The federal program providing free lunches for everyone has ended. Those eligible for free/reduced lunches must re-apply. Please print off the form, fill in the needed information and return to the school office in an envelope addressed to Mrs. Mary Siefker. Paper copies can also be picked up in the offices.

Kalida All Sports Passes

Kalida Schools are selling the Sports Passes in the Superintendent's office during the week from 7:30 to 3:30 p.m.

Family All-Sports Pass

Adult \$125, Student/Sr. Citizen \$90, Family \$350

Fall Only Pass

Adult \$70 or Student/Sr. Citizen \$50

Winter Only Pass

Adult \$80 or Student/Sr. Citizen \$50

Varsity ticket prices in the PCL were raised to \$7 last year for adults and \$5 for students at the door for soccer, volleyball and girls' basketball games. Pre-sale tickets are offered for home boys' basketball games for \$7/\$5. All tickets at the door are \$7. JH and freshmen game prices are \$4/\$3.

Current Covid Rules

The Ohio Department of Health has updated its guidance for Ohio K-12 schools and recommending the CDC's general guidance to best protect Ohio's students in the school setting.

Because contact tracing and case investigation has shifted to focus on high-risk environments, such as long-term care facilities and healthcare settings, ODH is no longer recommending the *Mask to Stay, Test to Play* quarantine alternative for schools. Instead, ODH recommends schools follow **general isolation procedures** from the CDC for confirmed cases.

If students or staff feel sick or suspect they might have COVID-19, they should stay home and take a rapid test. If positive, students and staff should stay home from school for at least 5 days and longer if necessary until fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication) and symptoms are improving. Additionally, after isolation ends, students and staff should continue to take precautions as they resume normal activities by wearing a mask for 5 days (or after two negative tests 48 hours apart).

Kalida Local will work closely with the health department to monitor community spread and make decisions about the best measures to protect students and staff based on what is happening in our community.
